

For large open plan living and the ability to distribute heat to all areas of your home, choose the robust Solitaire which can take a log length of up to 480mm front to back. All Eureka Bay Window Units are standard with a powerful 3-speed fan, one piece toughened ceramic glass, firebrick lined for increased efficiency and minimal wall clearances coupled with maximum heat output make the Eureka Bay Window an ideal choice for your home.



COOKER




